Get your puppy used to different things to make it easier for him to move in busy areas even as an adult.



Do not let your dog greet other dogs or people without permission.









Do not let your dog mark buildings or other property.

Clean up dog poop from the environment in maintained areas.

Do not stop in paths or junctions with your dog if an unfamiliar dog with its owner tries to pass you.



Walk with your dog in a way that allows those going faster to pass you easily.



Do not walk your dog on children's playgrounds, ski tracks maintained for public use, sports fields, public beaches, or market places.
